


Yanaka Cemetery


Yanaka Cemetery was established on September 1, 1874, using the land which the Yanaka Tennenji Temple possessed, which later became part of Tokyo Prefecture. It was transferred to Tokyo City in 1889 and became Tanninaka Cemetery in 1935, which is what it is called today.

The east side of the cemetery is sloped, but the rest is flat and relatively quiet. There are old trees and cherry blossoms throughout.

The location is a little complicated because there are many temples in the area. The site used to be a location for a famous five-story pagoda, which was quoted in the novel written by Koda Lohan. The grave of 3 places (graves of Sakusuke Obana, Yosai Kikuchi, Shigetomi Ohara) are registered as a cultural heritage.
