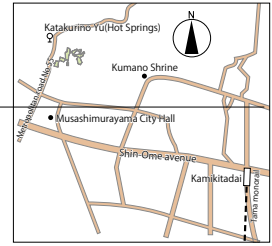


Nakato Park

Nakato Park is located in the central south part of the Sayama Hills. It plays a major role in constructing a network of the Sayama Hills' water and greenery which includes urban parks and greenery such as Noyamakita-Rokudoyama Park on the west and Higashiyamato Park and Sayama Park on the east, as well as the Tama lake (Murayama Reservoir) on the north. The park has mixed trees of mainly sawtooth oak and bao li trees and rich natural environment where various living creatures grow.

The new opening Yato has Bantaike pond and Akasaka pond as well as historical and cultural resources such as the Kichijoyama mountain.



Daidara-bocchi's well

Legend has it that the footsteps of a giant, Daidara-bocchi, who carried Mt. Maruyama with wistaria-vine became a well. The spring water did not dry up even during a drought and was once used as drinking water.
