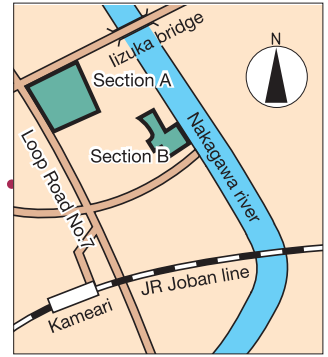


Oasis on the roof of a wastewater processing plant

# Nakagawa Park



**Location** ● Nakagawa 5-chome, Adachi Ward

**Transport** ● 15-minute walk from Kameari (JR Joban line connection to Chiyoda line). Toll parking facilities available (24 hours).

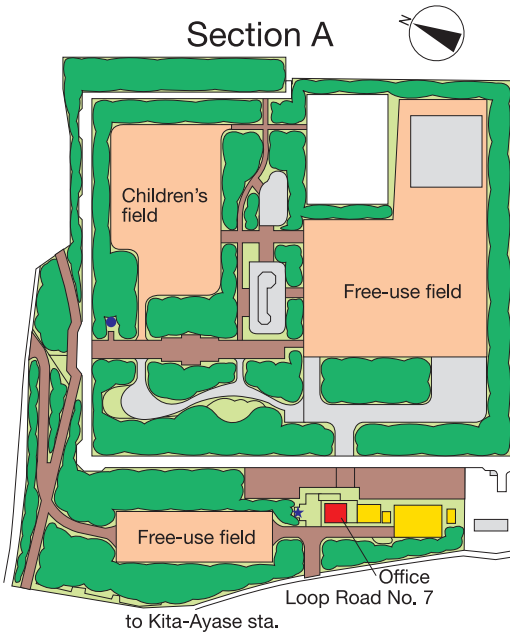


Nakagawa Park is sandwiched between Nakagawa River flowing in eastern Tokyo and Loop Road No. 7. Climb the stairway at the park entrance and you hear the sound of flowing water. The reason for that is that the park is built on the roof of a wastewater processing plant.

**Green field** ● While busy Kan-Nana Road runs nearby, the sound of cars seems far away. That is one added effect of greenery. Nakagawa Park has many trees that bear fruit, such as apricots, the Chinese quince, and tangerines. See if you can find them.

**Main plants** Konara oak, cherry (Oshima-zakura), maple, wax myrtle, gardenia, white perulatus, orange osamanthus, flowering quince, Japanese apricot, rose, Chinese quince, camellia, sasanqua,  
**Facilities** Wooden playground equipment, childrens playground
