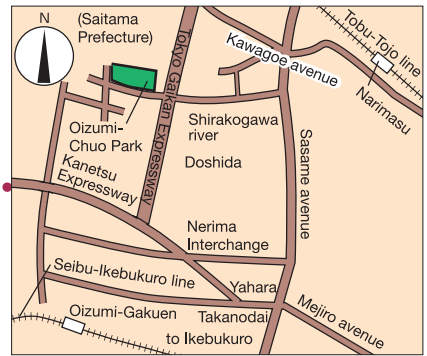


Greenery, water, and sunshine

Oizumi-Chuo Park

Situated on Tokyo's border with Saitama Prefecture, Izumi-Chuo Park is part of what was once an Imperial army academy and then the US military's Camp Asama after World War II. The part that became the park was used as a golf course for the base.

After the land was returned from the US military, it was developed as an approximately 10-hectare park. Izumi-Chuo Park opened in June 1990.

The park has a pond that makes lavish use of water, befitting the name Oizumi, which means large spring in Japanese. It also has a baseball field, athletic field, sunny field, and other facilities for sports and recreation under the open sky. Oizumi-Chuo Park is known as a park where everyone from small children to the elderly can have fun in safety and comfort.

Trees	Japanese apricot, orange osmanthus, Japanese zelkova, cherry (someiyoshino, yama-zakura, Japanese bird cherry), dogwood, Japanese camellia, kousa dogwood
Facilities	Baseball field (equipped for night games, fee required), athletic field (400 m track, fee required), fountain, wooden playground equipment, sandbox

Water square ● The water square is just inside the park's west entrance, presenting an image that fits the Oizumi name. A large fountain and monument in the square present visitors with a refreshing image.

Sunny field ● The sunny field with its small hill and wideopen lawn is a relaxing space where families to enjoy picnics. It also has a sandbox for young children to play in.

Wild bird forest ● Next to the water square is a forest great for watching wild birds. Why not come with the family to forget the bustle of the city and enjoy a day of bird watching?

Sports facilities ● Facilities in the park include a sports ground with an athletic field, 400-meter tracks, and a baseball field that can be lit up for night games. There are also stretching boards, monkey bars, and other equipment for strength-building exercises.
